## **Birdlife International**








- Partnership of national NGOs

## Partnership between BirdLife and PAGGW

#### MoU signed on 27 March 2019

#### 1) Restoration of land ecosystems

**2) Development of capacities** of national and local institutions and organizations

**3) Use and information** sharing on the status and trends of birds and their habitats

**4) Technical and scientific support** for the development and application of inventory and assessment frameworks and tools

**5) Support awareness and advocacy** for better planning and sustainable management of biodiversity

## Interests of partnerships between organizations with complementary skills

- Nature Mauritanie contributes to the GGW plan by participation in restoration of degraded land and they have been offered seedling to plant trees.
- Naturama: participates in sites activities and SURRAGWA project development and ensures the monitoring of biodiversity. Tree planting, improved stoves, development of value chains
- Nigeria Conservation Foundation is involved in the implementation of Site Support Group activities and restoration
- Nature-Communauté-Development (NCD) in Senegal is supporting the set up of Site Support Groups in Ferlo and restoration as well,
- Establish National working groups for biodiversity monitoring

   involve organization and institutions working on biodiversity.
- Working with Integrated Community Farms
- Collaboration with OSS, OHMi, Sahara Conservation Fund, Toogga, University Gaston Berger, FAO RESSOURCE project, RAMSESII





What systems of preparation, identification of projects, provision of funds and monitoring should be put in place ?

- BirdLife with the national partners has develop a program to support the PAGGW
- Recruitment of secondment staff to PAGGW
- BirdLife partners support national agencies of GGW for the identification of project proposals.
- Integration of the SSGs and FACIs approach
- Funding and expertise mobilized within BirdLife Partnership (VBN, RSPB,....).
- Communities capacity developed for the monitoring of biodiversity and Ecosystem services (IBA/KBA framework, TESSA)

### The short- and medium-term expected benefits for the local groups and for the GGW

- Empowerment and ownership of the initiative by the communities,
- Improvement of the Livelihood, development of values chains
- Capacity building of the communities for management, governance,...
- Monitoring of biodiversity and ecosystem services
- Integration of biodiversity into their activities
- Policy and advocacy connecting local to national and global
